

# Adoption Application

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It is highly recommended that all family members meet the new pet before adopting to be sure there are no allergies and to make sure everyone gets along. If this is a second dog, please have your pet with you for the meet and greet.

There is an adoption fee for every dog and puppy adopted through Animal Care Centre Lobo. All dogs have received initial vaccines (please note that dogs under 4 months old age have not received their rabies vaccination and no dog has received bordetella vaccine, or leptospirosis vaccine). All dogs have been microchipped. All dogs over 6 months of age have also been spayed/neutered and heartworm tested.

There will be a minimum 24 hour waiting period between when the application is filled out and adoption. This gives you an opportunity to prepare for a new dog and gives us a chance to review your application and to contact references.
